

- ❖ First of all, create a very detailed persona. Anything you find important. Name, sex, pronouns, etc. You don't see bots settings (and you can't change them) so make sure YOU are a good written character that interacts with bot.
- ❖ Always pay attention to what is written in the bot's description. If you see a copy-paste mess - better skip this AI. There is a small chance bot is adjusted for the role-play.
- ❖ Separate what your character is saying and doing. Remember, you interact with AI, it needs clear instructions. Example of what I am talking about: "Hey, what are we going to have for dinner?" John asks carefully not to anger his tired wife. As you see, speech text is written with " symbol. Anything else is up to your preference.
- ❖ Make your responses detailed. AI is your partner in crime - give it something to "chew". Describe with what tone you answer, what action you are doing, etc. It helps bot a lot to understand the current mood of your character and expectations.
- ❖ Bot seems to not understand you? Write down as a narrator. Explain WHAT is expected. "It will kill role-play immersion!" you can say. No, it won't. You are speaking with AI that sometimes needs a lead.
- ❖ Feel free to edit AI's messages. Make responses shorter \ longer, change actions, add motivation etc. Shape the mood of the character for your own needs.
- ❖ Check available prompts for LLM to make responses better. [Example](#) (thank you Devil_Herself_)
