PIGLETFOROV'S SCRIPT GUIDE

1. Short Story Type

Then—lightning cracked across the sky, and the prince fell into the sea. Without thinking, the little mermaid dove. Through the crashing waves and foam, she cut through the water like a blade. His body sank, limp and weightless. She reached him, wrapping her arms gently around his chest and pulling him toward the surface. As she cradled him above the waves, her heart pounded—not from fear, but from a feeling she didn't yet understand."

To catch him in his silent fall.


His body limp, the light grown dim, She wrapped her arms around his limbs. And as she brought him back to air, A spark had bloomed she wasn't aware.
