



Executive Activity Report

January 2025

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Chair Tyler Mullins of New Athens

This was the first month of the new term. It began humbly, like many others with appointments and nominations to fill the executive and permanent office. The following offices were filled by the following individuals:

Three quorums were held successfully, and one unsuccessfully-The EU/Asia quorum failed to meet the minimum attendance requirement. The Charter clearly states that the GUM has a duty to make every reasonable effort to equally accommodate all delegates regardless of their time zone, so any adjustments to quorum scheduling will need to be navigated to ensure that fairness, efficiency, and legal compliance are all upheld. Delegates should stay tuned for an update on this very soon. The application tracking and attendance tracking sheets were updated at the start of the month.

The Chair proposed two events to be possibly held during this term: a Culture Festival and an olympic-style online games competition. Hearing support, the plan for these events will be developed further and announced soon. In addition, the delegate of Adammia brought to quorum's attention that the GUM Development Awards have not been held since 2022 and proposed a revival to the event. As a result, the Chair intends to host the 2024 GUM Development Awards to recognize achievements made in 2024 very soon, and encourages the next Chair to host an awards event for 2025 at the end of the year.

Quorum unanimously passed a motion to abandon the use of the GUM's Twitter (X) account. As a result, the account will no longer be utilized. There has been some support for bluesky, and it may be good to get on that train early to establish the GUM as a champion of the micronational community on the platform. The account would be used to share GUM news, such as reports from the Communications Secretary, events and election results, for example, in addition to sharing member news in order to highlight activity for both the member and the GUM.
