

A Night of All that Jazz

When: April 8th from 6:00 to 8:30 pm **Where:** EWA Gym

Who: 5th grade through 8th grade students (no guests allowed)

Our dance theme for the Spring is "A Night of All That Jazz" which will be a gold, black, and white classy gala indicative of the 1920's and Gatsby. **Students may come to the dance dressed in casual attire or they may dress up; this is their choice.** Be sure to follow the dress code as it applies to dress down day. Students are not required to dress up to match the dance theme as this is not a costume dance.

*Students must be present for school the day of the dance and counted for attendance or they may not attend.

For casual dress and dress up attire; the dress code rules are as follows:

- Jeans, t-shirts, sneakers, and hats are permitted
- Shoulders must be covered or dresses **must** have straps and straps **must be at least 2"/3 fingers wide**
- Dresses, skirts, and shorts must be longer than the student's fingertips when their arms are by their sides
- Dresses should not be too tight or see through. Shorts should be worn under dresses.
- **No clothing should be ripped or torn.**

*Please be aware that any student not dressed appropriately will have to call home for a change of clothes at the discretion of the MASC Advisor/Administration.

Dance tickets will be sold for \$5.00 in advance on Tuesday, April 6th and Wednesday, April 7th during lunchtime in Middle Academy Spirit Hall. Additionally, tickets will be sold at the door for \$7.00; please bring exact change.

Optional Dinner: Students may also pre order a Chick-Fil-A sandwich for 5.00 when purchasing tickets on April 6th and 7th. All sandwich orders must be placed by end of day April 7th, no exceptions.

At the Dance: Refreshments (soda, candy, gatorade, water, pickles) will be available at an additional cost of 1.00 each; all proceeds will go to Middle Academy Student Council and to pay for the dance.

Photos: Students will have a selfie-station available to take their own pictures along with props and background.

Parent chaperones will NOT be needed. Teachers are required to chaperone the dance so parents, this means you get to take the night off! Enjoy your night and **be lined up for carpool by 8:15 pm to pick up your child. Students will be released from the gym at 8:30 into carpool where Teachers will be working to ensure that they safely get to cars.**
