

Formal Event Dress Code

Below are the expectations of dress code for students to abide by to attend formal events at Valley Christian School.

Girl Section (to be used by all female students or guests):

- Dress has at least one strap.
- Dress is not too tight; no undergarments may be showing.
- Dress is high enough to cover all cleavage.
- Dress must cover the point on the back opposite of the belly button.
- Dress must be longer than fingertips with arms at side.
- If a slit is present, it must be lower than fingertips when arms are at side.
- Dress code compliant covering worn under any transparent sections of the dress

Boy Section (to be used by all male students or guests):

- Shirt has a collar, sleeves and buttons.
- Tie/Bow tie is required (Prom only)
- If no undershirt is worn, buttons must remain closed with no more than the top two buttons open.
- Pants are khaki or dress material, extend to the ankle and are free from rips or tears.
- Dress or tennis shoes required

Recommendation

We recommend that a parent ensures an outfit meets guidelines by viewing it while the student is wearing it as outfits can look very different on a hanger.

Parents and students should be aware that if a student arrives at the event with clothing that does not meet dress code requirements, that student will be asked to change into an outfit that is within these guidelines prior to admittance.
