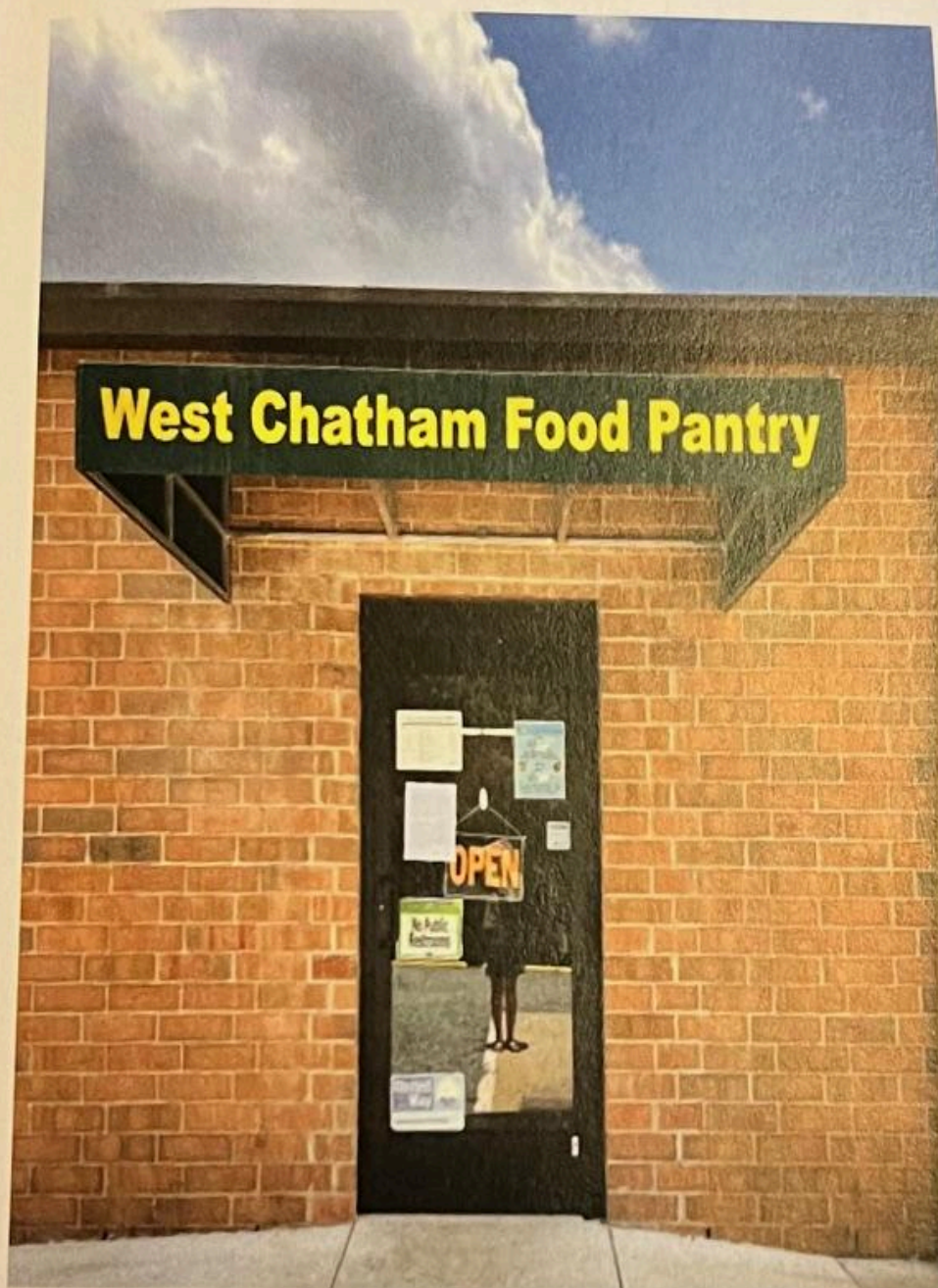


West Chatham Food Pantry



Brief History



The West Chatham Food Pantry is a 501(c)3 that was established in 2007. We are an all volunteer pantry whose sole purpose is to help feed the hungry throughout Chatham County. Since opening our doors, qualifying families have been able to receive food from our facility every 14 days, if needed.

The pantry is supporting Chatham County School's FUEL UP program. This is a weekend backpack program that provides grocery supplements to qualifying elementary school children. Each backpack contains healthy food items including such things as fruit, meat, vegetables, breakfast items, juice and healthy snacks.

We have been faithfully supported by area churches, businesses, civic organizations and individuals. Thanks to their generosity we are able to provide for the need in our community

Eligibility Requirements

- ☆ Written referral from approved agency
- ☆ Food Stamp recipient
- ☆ If an applicant does not meet one of the eligibility requirements he/she may provide income and expense info for possible approval
- If an applicant lives outside
- ☆ Chatham County, he/she must have a referral from pastor of supporting church after the initial visit and must also meet eligibility requirements.

Emergency situations such as, ☆
but not limited to, fire, natural disasters, etc., will be handled on an individual basis

Clients must provide:

- * Photo ID
- * Proof of Residence
- * Proof of names and ages of all household members
- * Household income and expenses
