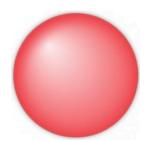
Event Packet: End of Year Celebration/Commitments

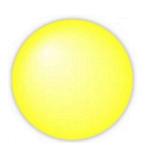

Chat & Chew: End of Year Reflection

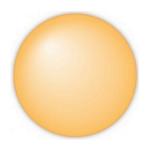
After each person has grabbed a handful of candy, use the following guide to reflect on and discuss this school year as a table group.



For every **RED Skittle** you have, share one thing you're excited about for next year.



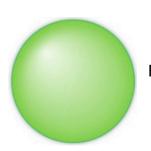
For every **YELLOW Skittle** you have, share a proud moment from this year.
