God Questions

- Is there a Supreme Being that created everything and holds it all together?
- If such a Being exists, is He a personal Being or an impersonal force?
- Does He know what's going on?
- Is He everywhere?
- Is God active in human affairs or is He passive? If He is active, does He communicate with us? And if He does communicate then how do we hear Him?

Creation Questions

- Did the universe make itself?
- If it wasn't made by itself, where did it come from? Is there a cause behind it?
- Is physical matter actually sustained through time by the Creator? Or does it function all on its own?
- Does this material world have any great purpose or value? And if it does, what is the basis of that value?
- What is really real?

Humanity Questions

- Were we once fish?
- Are we really the result of a lot of time plus a lot of chance plus a lot of impersonal matter?
- How can we say that we, humans, have any value? What's the basis of our worth?
- Are we basically good or corrupt?
- Are we responsible for our behavior?
- Are we accountable for our actions?
- Are we caused to do what we do by our upbringing and environment?
- What happens to us after we die?

Moral Order Questions

- Are morality and order determined by ourselves? Or are they prescribed by a higher being?
- Is there an ultimate standard of right and wrong?
- If so, then what is that standard and who makes the rules?
- What is the role of the family?
- What is the role of civil government?
- Is there a final judgment?
- If so, on what basis is that judgment made?

Purpose Questions

- Is there any great purpose or meaning?
- Does history have any direction to it?
- Is there a reason for the material resources that exist in our world?
- Is there any sort of expectation on human beings?
