Goals and Objectives

Grading

This class will have homework assignments throughout the week. There will also be quizzes, tests and projects that occur in this class. Due dates for assignments, or dates for upcoming assessments will be provided to you so that you will have time to prepare. Finally you are expected to take notes and participate in all classroom activities; they count towards your grade. Should a student receive a 50% or lower on a test or quiz, they will have one opportunity to retake it. Honors students can earn up to a 70%, general education students can earn up to a 75%.

Classroom Policies

- 1. **Absences:** Check online(google classroom, and whatever grade monitoring system we have) for assignments that you have missed. Students should also talk to me either before school, during lunch, or after school to verify what work may have been missed(via school e-mail). Students have as many days as they were absent to complete missing work.
- **2.** Late work: I will accept any late work for half credit as long as it is for the current quarter.
- 3. Cheating: Cheating in this classroom will not be tolerated. If you are caught cheating you will receive a 0 for your test(or quiz) as well as parent and administrator notification. COMMUNICATION/INTERACTION WITH OTHER STUDENTS DURING A TEST IS CHEATING.

Behavior Consequences

- **1. Behavior Reflection Form:** Students who are continually disrupting class will receive a phone call or e-mail to their parents along with a small assignment to complete. Repeated issues will be reported to the administrators.
- 2. Responsibility Center (RC): Students who are continually disruptive after being talked to/receiving behavior reflection form will be sent to the RC. Parents will be notified.
- **3. Assistant Principal Referral:** Students whose behavior is extremely disruptive, inappropriate, or dangerous will be sent to the office to speak with an Administrator. Parents will be notified if this happens.
