Bib / Athlete swag bag pick up: Thursday, March 28 from 5:00-7:30 PM at Arlberg Sports located at 25 N Wenatchee Ave., Wenatchee WA 98801. *Please make every effort to pick up your packet during this time period.*

Sunday Bib pick up: 7:30-8:00 AM in the lodge

Bibs: Bibs will be collected at the finish line Saturday and Sunday. Please keep your bib from Friday for Saturday.

Race Registration: Enter online via adminskiracing.com and filter the Events for the PNW Division to find MRST races.

Entry Deadline: online registration will close Tuesday, March 19, 2024 at midnight. No late registrations will be allowed.

Seeding: Team seeding due Wednesday March 20 at 5pm. Coaches, use [THIS FORM](#) to submit your seeding.

Cost: \$165 for the event

Bib Deposit: \$75 charge per lost or damaged bib

Lifts: tickets for racers age 12 and below are \$50.00 + tax

Mission Ridge has an online ticketing system. Lift tickets MUST be purchased online in advance here:

No reciprocal/exchange or discount ticket offers are valid for race days.

1. Before March 29, go to the above link and purchase your ticket. If you already have a Mission Ridge RFID card and account, purchase the ticket under your existing Mission Ridge account. If you do not have a Mission Ridge account, create one and upload a photo, then sign the online waiver that will be emailed to you (*this is separate from the required race waiver*). Your new account and ticket purchase will include the purchase of an RFID card that can be re-loaded for future tickets (not just this season). We do not recommend trying to purchase online tickets in the parking lot as reception is not reliable. Tickets purchased at the ticket window will dramatically increase wait times – *please pre-purchase*.
2. On March 29, go to the ticket window and pick up your pre-paid pass. Do not discard it – this ticket/card will work for future visits.
3. If you need a *replacement* Mission Ridge RFID card, go to <https://estore.missionridge.com/special-events/products/rfid-card-purchase-replacement>. The cost for the replacement card is \$5 + tax.

Coach tickets: Coaches must be USSS registered coaches and signed up on AdminSkiRacing.com to receive a complimentary ticket. Maximum four coach tickets per team.
