
Senior Spotlight: Drake Bird

This week's music review goes to Reputation by Taylor Swift. Reputation is Taylor's sixth studio album released on November 10, 2017, through Big Machine Records. Taylor produced the album with Jack Antonoff, Max Martin, and Shellback. The album is a mix of electropop, synth-pop, and R&B with elements of urban styles such as hip-hop, trap, and EDM. Taylor took an autobiographical songwriting approach on Reputation. She references her romantic relationships and celebrity disputes. The songs form a linear narrative of a narrator seeking vengeance against wrongdoers, but ultimately finds solace in a blossoming love. This album features singles like "...Ready for it?" and "Look What You Made Me Do". Overall, the aesthetic of this album seems to lean more on the vengeance theme rather than the more lovey side, with the main mascot of the album being a snake. I personally would say this is one of Taylor's best albums song, lyric, and even aesthetic wise.
