Executive Summary:


The Octagon Barn of San Luis Obispo got its start as a place for dairy farming. Today, the center stands as a facility designed for public use for a plethora of different needs. Recently added to the National Registry of Historic Places with the help of The Land Conservancy, The Octagon Barn Center's current mission is to serve as a community gathering place that brings people together. As such an integral piece of the history of San Luis Obispo, and now a place for new opportunities of growth in the community, The Octagon Barn Center deserves the perfect first unveiling.

The Community Grand Opening will be the first event held at the center and our goal is to produce an event that highlights the potential that the new and improved Octagon Barn Center has to offer for the community, while showcasing the rich history and relevance of the barn. This event will be free of charge and open to the public. In order to spread the word about the event and the new center itself to the public, we will use flyers that we have created for advertising on various social media platforms, as well as set up a booth at Thursday night Farmers Market. Aside from this, we will ask and encourage the various local businesses involved to help spread the word about the grand opening event. Educating the public and getting them excited about the new piece of their community is key to our event's success. As for the event itself, getting to the venue is not difficult and navigating the venue will be made even easier with clear signs placed strategically around the entrance. Once attendees arrive and park in the parking lot, they will be greeted by a large balloon arch as they walk down the stairs and enter the venue. Once inside, guests have the choice to participate in any number of activities that are going on. Activities throughout the day will include: a corn hole tournament, a silent baked goods auction in the milking parlor, a historical presentation of the barn, a number of local performances in the amphitheater, and a kids zone with a bounce house and face painting.

On top of the activity options, local vendors will be catering their delicious food for the event. Mo's Barbeque will serve a SLO-inspired barbeque meal cafeteria style for the event, and Batch Ice Cream will have an ice cream truck on site for tasty treats and a fun dessert. A photo booth will be set up at the event so that guests have the ability to capture the moment and remember it forever. The silent baked goods auction provides guests with another great opportunity to take home a piece of the event. The look and feel of the event is created to align with the integrity of the barn itself, while mirroring the community as a whole. We have chosen a traditional rustic barn theme using various woods, sunflowers, wagon wheels, and lanterns. The choice of local vendors, entertainment and even BBQ as a meal choice are used to showcase the community, which is really what this event is all about. The Octagon Barn Center is an important piece of San Luis Obispo's history and with this community grand opening we hope to prove how it will continue to be just as, if not more, beneficial for the community currently and in all the years to come.

Event Vision:





Our vision for this event is a community, and family driven event to celebrate the opening of the long-awaited Octagon Barn Center. We drew our theme inspiration from the rustic nature of the barn. We will use the windmill, sunflowers, hay, and the colors of blue and yellow to decorate the space, both inside and outside. The activites will include a corn hole tournament, live music from local bands and schools, as well as a baking auction to feature community members. In addition, there will also be jump houses, and face painters to include the entire family. To go along with the barn atmosphere, we will be serving BBQ food, with the Batch Ice Cream truck for dessert. We want this event to be open to the community as a whole, and provide to all age groups.

Food and Beverage Proposal and Menu Selection:



We used local tastes of the San Luis Obispo area to inspire our menu for the Grand Opening of the Octagon Barn. Lunch will be served Cafeteria style and dessert will be served by a food truck outside. For lunch, community favorite, Mo's Barbeque, will be the caterer and for dessert Batch, a local business that specializes in ice-cream cookie sandwiches, will be serving out of their food truck. The beverages served at this community event will be iced tea, water, and lemonade.

Mo's Barbecue:


For lunch, we wanted to choose a meal that is essential to SLO and that tied in with the history of the Octagon Bard. With that in mind, we chose Mo's Barbecue to cater our lunch. Recently reopened this past January after renovations, Mo's has been a staple to the central coast for over 20 years, meaning not only do they have the capability of feeding large groups of people, but they also have plenty of experience in the catering world. Mo's provides a variety of options for those with dietary restrictions and are happy to accommodate which is essential to our event, since we are inviting a wide demographic of people. We are also hoping that with the reopening in mind and our community-centered event that we will potentially get a discount for the catering.



Batch Truck:


Since our event is causal, we wanted a dessert that could be simple yet cater to all ages, while still showcasing a local vendor. We also wanted a dessert that would allow our guests to be mobile, so as to encourage more community networking. With our needs in mind, we decided to choose the Batch Ice Cream truck. The truck is the perfect fit for our event, as it touches on the history of the barn (cows/milk) with the ice cream sandwiches and will also be a refreshing desert on what is expected to be a warm afternoon. Batch also allows customers to choose their cookies, ice cream, and toppings, which will give community members infinite options.

Overall Floor Plan:



This floor plan is an overall bird's eye view of the venue in order to get perspective on where all of the activities and vendors will be placed. The batch truck will be in the middle of the milking barn and the amphitheatre to catch people's attention when they are exciting either facility and to keep the line from interfering with the other activities occuring. Also, the corn hole tournament was placed in the middle of the venue to lure people into playing and for people to watch if they are interested. Another aspect that we added was the Photo Booth that will be on the side of the Octagon Barn near all of the other activities so people will frequently see it and be interested in using. Lastly, the kid zone is on the far left hand side of the venue because the bounce house will take up a lot of room and we wanted all of the children's activities to be centralized together so they get the most use. With this floor plan we hope to achieve a balanced venue that does not include traffic jams or having hidden activities.

Octagon Space Floor Plan:



Mo's BBQ will be serving food for the event in the Octagon Barn. We will set up six 6' tables in a "u" shape in the middle of the barn where food will be served. Servers will be in the middle of the "u" giving guests their food. This will be done to ensure that attendees do not take too much. Twenty 6' tables will be placed in the Octagon Barn for eating. With 8 guests at each table, this will allow for up to 160 people to sit and eat at once. Lunch will be served for two hours so not all attendees will be eating at the same time. Guests will be able to eat whenever they want from 2:00-4:00. Highboys will also be placed in the Octagon Barn for guests to stand and eat.

This floor plan is a birds eye view of the Octagon Barn Shed. We included a long rectangular table and theatre style seating. The shed includes six toilets for guests to use, as well as storage space. This is where the local artists will perform, and where we will present the historical exhibit.

Activities & Entertainment:

For the activities and entertainment, there will be a corn hole tournament, face painting, local band performances, a silent baked goods auction, a jumpy house, food being served, as well as the Batch truck for a tasty dessert. We felt as though bringing local bands to come perform was a great way to represent the community and bring people together. We included face painting and a jumpy house so that kids will have a memorable experience at the Octagon Barn with other members of their community. We decided to choose the corn hole game because we felt as though it aligned with our theme for the entire event, and would be a fun way for teams to compete.
