Important Attendance Information

ABSENCE REPORTING & CLEARANCE PROCEDURES

To report a student's absence:

- Parents/guardians should contact the school at 831-646-6590 (option 1) on the day of the absence - **LEAVE A MESSAGE**.
- If no notification is received by 9:00 A.M., an automated call will notify the parent/guardian via a phone call and email.
- **All absences must be officially cleared within 72 hours via phone call, a written note, a Parent Vue message, or an email to attendancepghs@pgusd.org.** Any absence not cleared within this 72-hour window will be recorded as **unexcused**.
- For convenience, a 24-hour voicemail system is available for attendance updates. Due to the high volume of correspondence, individual confirmations will not be sent. Following an excused absence, students hold the responsibility to complete all make-up work.

EARLY RELEASE & OFF-CAMPUS PASSES

- If a student needs to leave campus before the conclusion of their regular school day, a parent or guardian must notify the attendance office at least **30 minutes in advance**. Notification can be provided by calling 831-646-6590 (option 1), **providing a written note, sending a Parent Vue message, or emailing attendancepghs@pgusd.org**.
- We highly encourage advanced notice, including details on where the student will be picked up. **To minimize classroom disruptions, passes will not be delivered to classrooms; please remind your student to collect their off-campus pass from the Attendance Office before school, during break, or at lunch.**
- Whenever possible, medical and dental appointments should be scheduled during open periods or outside of school hours.
- Students who leave campus without prior parental notification will be categorized as truant.

In order to be eligible for **off-campus privileges** at lunch next school year, incoming Seniors will need 36 hours of service learning. Incoming Juniors, will need 24 hours of service learning to be eligible for **off-campus privileges** next school year. Incoming Sophomores need to start the year with 12 hours of service learning. CAMPUS SAFETY INFORMATION

Safety Reminders:

- The speed limit in the school zones is **25 miles per hour**. It is **10 MPH or LESS** in the parking lots.
- **U-turns are NOT allowed** in or around the parking lot driveways or in front of the school.
- Please **do not proceed** through the crosswalks until all, all, ALL pedestrians and crossing guards have made it to the sidewalks.
- **Students may not park in the spaces in front or back of the school** but must use the designated parking lots.
- Please **do not drop off students on the opposite side of the school**. There are no crosswalks available to them and it is very dangerous.
- The driveway leading to and the parking area behind the cafeteria/student union area are for **delivery vehicles and school bus drop offs ONLY**, not for band students or instruments. There should be no student or staff parking or drop off. This creates a dangerous situation for everyone. Thank you for your understanding and finding an alternate place to park or drop off. Students may not park in the spaces in front or back of the school but must use the designated parking lots.

****Students:** driving on campus is a privilege. Please drive safely or parking in the parking lots may be revoked.

- Just a reminder: students are not allowed to be in the PE locker room area or that vicinity during break or lunch. You can only be on the weightroom/**meadow side of the gym** but no other areas around the gym during these times.
- Please **use your lockers** to store your personal items. Do not leave belongings in classrooms, as we will *no longer be unlocking classrooms* for students to retrieve items during the day. You can find your locker information in the Synergy app or with Mrs. Afifi. Thank you for your cooperation!
