Main purpose of the role:

Establish and record test sessions for club members and community.

What does the role do?

Identify when test sessions are needed for club members. Organize test sessions by booking ice time, finding officials, and recording results with U.S. Figure Skating.

What skills, experience, and attributes are needed?

- **As a board member you must have a SkateSafe certification**
- **Must have an active Utah FSC membership**
- Secure test date ice time
- Find judges who are available for the test
- Open test session on Entreeyz 45 days prior to the test session
- Register all tests with USFSA
- Create a test schedule
- Facilitate test sessions
- Enter all results with USFSA
- Enter all IJS test protocols with USFSA throughout the year

What is the time commitment?

This is a two season commitment as a board member for the club
