

# Holiday Gift Baskets - <u>Created by our Spanish River Chapter</u> Recommended for All Ages

Students will create holiday gift baskets that include gift cards, holiday plushies, and holiday snacks/treats.

## 1. Getting Started

- Decide how many children you wish to gift these to and commit to that number.
- Email <u>marisa@speakupforkidspbc.org</u> and ask for a list of names. Please provide as many details as you can about who, age, group, specific instruction wishes about the types of children, grades, etc.

\*NOTE: Plan way ahead. You will be given a deadline that is about one month out since it takes time to connect and deliver the items to the children\*

- Begin working on your project. Take LOTS of pictures along the way and send them to us, so we can give you a shout-out during your process.
- Stay in touch along the way, so we know the status of your project and if you are on-target for your delivery date.
- When finished, organize and label your gift baskets so it's clear where they are going. We will provide instructions.
- Contact the same email for a delivery date and make arrangements with us to collect the items from you.

#### Supplies needed:

- Shoeboxes & wrapping paper
- Holiday plushie/ stuffed animal
- Gift Card
- Holiday themed snacks

\*Please do not include any candy/chocolate that will melt easily\*

# 2.Launching Your Project:

- If this is your FIRST PROJECT with STUDENTS Speak Up for Kids:

If you haven't logged onto our NEW volunteer platform yet, please follow the steps above.

- 1. Complete the steps from "Launching Your Project" steps from above.
- 2. Track your hours for learning, planning, launching, social media time, etc.
