These are the guidelines for completing the CAS Research Paper (Artifact 1).

1. Choose one of the following UN Sustainable goals that has been assigned to your grade level. Keep in mind that when you choose a UN sustainable goal, not only are you going to complete a research paper on that goal, but you are also going to partner with a local organization that is addressing the issue. This also includes creating an awareness campaign and volunteering time towards helping solve this problem.

- 2. Complete a research paper on the goals you choose. The research paper must answer the following questions:
 - a. How is this a problem that impacts the entire world?
 - b. How does this problem impact your local community?
 - c. How does this issue impact you personally?
 - d. How have you personally experienced or interacted with this issue before?
 - e. What are people/countries/organizations doing to try to fix this issue?
- 3. The paper should be over 300 words and cite a minimum of 3 sources.
- 4. Once the paper has been finished and proofread and approved by your connections teacher you must upload the paper onto your student portfolio website.
