

SCHOLARSHIPS

Legitimate scholarship opportunities are free to apply. You should never pay to apply for scholarships. There are many free websites to search for scholarships. For those that need a log in, be aware that they may sell your information. Deadlines for scholarships are year-round and can cover various costs of college (i.e. tuition, fees, books, housing, meals).

During the school year the FHS College and Career Team will be sending out additional information on scholarships through student email. Please be sure to monitor your email for additional scholarship information!
