Ladies and Gentlemen:

The Law & Ordinance Committee met on Oct. 17, 2007, at 5 p.m. at Hornell City Hall. Members present were Angelo Sciotti, Joseph Foreman, Jean Shepard, and Chairman Norton. Also present was Mayor Hogan.

Items discussed and acted upon are as follows:

- 1) Acted on the requirements for site plan review under §315-37C(c) of the Hornell City Codes to change such code so exterior alterations or additions to existing structures which would not increase the square footage of the existing structure by more than 25% and having a cost value of less than \$30,000. Motion by Sciotti, seconded by Foreman. Ayes all.
- 2) Acted on the Hornell City Code §160-9A on garbage receptacles. Said receptacles should be a minimum of 22 inches high, 14 inches in diameter at the top and 13 ½ inches in diameter at the bottom. Also, said receptacles will be covered. Garbage receptacles will be placed for easy access for the collector. Receptacles will be placed out no earlier than 7 a.m. on the day of pickup and shall be removed no later than at the end of business hours the following day after pickup. Motion by Shepard, seconded by Foreman. Ayes all.
- 3) Request from Alderman Sciotti that the area of East Elm and Riverside place be patrolled with a possibility of a stop sign being placed at that location. Mayor Hogan will have Chief Murray check the area and have the Police Department's speed trailer in the area also.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 5:25 p.m.
