Brown now has a CLEP testing lab that is exclusively for our students. CLEP (College Level Examination Program) is a testing program that allows students to take an exam (typically an hour) and receive college credit if they meet a passing score. I opened a CLEP lab at Moore several years ago and students had a great deal of success in passing these exams. Many students who did not receive a passing score on the AP exam successfully passed the CLEP exam in several subjects, including math, Spanish, English Composition and United States History. If you explore the website, you will see the exams offered ([CLEP Exams](#)). I encourage you to look at the sample questions that are provided for each exam and then, if interested, the study guides. There are a few exams that may be beneficial to many students right away without too much additional preparation. One is the College Composition test (worth 3 credit hours) and the College Composition Modular (worth 6 credit hours). If you are an advanced writer, ask your Language Arts teacher if you think this test is for you. For native Spanish speakers or advanced Spanish students can provide up to six hours of college credit and potentially fulfill their college's foreign language requirement. It may also be worth your time to check out the various math exams.
