In MI Write:

1. Find the prompt you need to revise and edit.
2. Here is a list of [signal words](#) to help you improve your rough draft.
3. As you do your first revisions, it might help to separate sentences so it is easy to find the line that needs correction.
4. Each "Comment" box holds one to several suggestions for revision. Be sure you scroll through all the comments for each correction.
5. I suggest you focus on **SPELLING first**, then worry about **GRAMMAR second**.
6. Pull your sentences together to make it look like a paragraph (no big spaces or empty lines.)
7. Click "Submit."

NOW see SIX SCORES for your writing.

- The small green **G** means **MI Write has grammar suggestions for you.** Click on the **G** to read the recommendations.
- The small red **S** means **MI Write has spelling suggestions for you.** Click on the **S** to read the recommendations.
- Any text highlighted in GRAY means MI Write has other types of suggestions for you.
 - Again, click on the letter in the box at the beginning of the highlighted sections to read MI Write's recommendations.

Once you have read MI Write's suggestions, go to the REVISE button on the right and click.

- Your goal is to have **no errors.** You can do it!
