Configuration ALLADA TSHIRT DESIGNER

This tutorial is a step by step guide to teach you how to create a custom product on a WooCommerce store using the Allada plugin.


A custom product configuration is a set of parameters that can be assigned to one or more WooCommerce products that regulate how they work. Assigning a custom product configuration to a normal WooCommerce product turns it into a customizable product.

The first step to making our product customizable is to create a configuration. A configuration is a set of options which once defined will allow our plugin to take charge of the process of customizing your product from the designer to the generation of printable output files. But before this step, we will first need to define the fonts that we are going to use in terms of text options, colors and clipart.

It is essential that after installing the plugin we start with the **Settings section** to generally configure the plugin. Among other things, the configurations will focus on **Uploads**, **Colors**, and **Licence** (a very important part to be able to **allow the customer to customize their product**).


• Settings:

In this section you define your parameters in general (Allada > Settings).



After passing the Setting section, let's continue with the Font Configuration.


• Fonts:



- Choose in the left sidebar the "Fonts" sub-tab of the Allada menu (Allada > Fonts)
- 2) Click on the "pick a google font" field
- 3) Search for your policy
- 4) Once you have chosen your font, click "Add Font"

Do not forget the definition of a font is mandatory. Once your fonts are defined, we can move on to the **Clipart configuration** step.


Cliparts:



- Choose in the left sidebar the "Clipart" sub-tab of the Allada menu (Allada > Clipart)
- 2) Click on the "new clipart group" button
- 3) Enter the name of the configuration of your clipart you want to assign to the product
- 4) At this level you have two choices, either upload the cliparts one by one or in multiple ways. Assuming you click on the "add clipart" button, you will see a row of information appear to add a clipart, define a name for the clipart and if possible set a price for it
- 5) If you finish, you can click on the "**publish**" button.

At this level you have the possibility to define **Colors Globally** to use on your configurator or on other configurations. Note that this is **Optional**.


• Colors Palettes:



This section (Allada > Colors Palettes) is similar to clipart, with the difference that instead of an add clipart button you just have an add color button. once activated, you can enter the name of your color and that of the hex code (Ex: # ff0000). You can access this section by clicking on the color palettes sub-tab which is located in the left sidebar of the Allada menu.

Now we can create our **Configuration** for our customizable products.

• Configurations:




- 1) Choose in the left sidebar the "Configuration" sub-tab of the Allada menu (Allada > Fonts)
- 2) Click on the "new configuration" button
- 3) Enter the name of the configuration you want to assign to the product
- 4) The next step is to configure the parts. Currently we have 5 configurable parts. The front, back, left arm, right arm and chest. you can activate or deactivate the part of your choice, define the border color of your edit area, and you also have the ability to define the name of your part which will be visible when configuring your t-shirt.
- 5) Below you have other configurations that will surely be useful to you, we have the use of global fonts defined in the left sidebar the "Font" sub-tab of the **Allada** menu or you

- even define fonts usable for this configuration only. Same process for the clipart area.
- 6) you have the possibility to activate or deactivate the team functionality according to your needs. In the event that you activate the team functionality, you will see other forms to be completed.
- 7) When finished you can click on the "Publish" button. Remember that you can add several configurations.


Apply configurations to our products

Once our configurations are done we will move on to the creation of a simple or variable product. We're assuming you already know how to create a wordpress product.


 Choose in the left sidebar the "Add new" sub-tab of the Products menu (Products > Add New)



2) We start on the basis of a **variable product**. In the Attribute tab we have created two attributes **Color** and **Size** with the information they need as shown in the image below.




3) In the variation tab we have created three variations




4) All the configuration of the t-shirt is played at this level, on the **T-shirt configuration** tab.


Edit Product



- a) At this level you define the correspondence of the **color** and **size** variation that you have defined at the level of the **attributes**, that is to say in the zone where you are asked for the color you choose the attribute which represents color (which you have defined yourself of course), valid for the size zone.
- b) when you click on the **Go** button, a **modal** will **open** allowing you to **choose the same configuration** (the configuration (s) that you defined in the configuration section of the allada plugin) for all your **T-shirt configuration** simultaneously which is located just after the **set default configuration** field.



- For each T-shirt configuration you can choose the configuration you like if you don't want to apply the same configuration for all your t-shirts at the same time
- d) At this level you will find the parts defined (part that you have activated) during the configuration in the configuration sub-tab of the allada menu. For each part you can define the icon and background corresponding to that part specifically which will be visible in the configurator.



Once these instructions are finished you register and go to the product from your site. Choose the size and color of which you have defined a configuration in the **T-shirt configuration** tab. Then click on the **Design now** button
