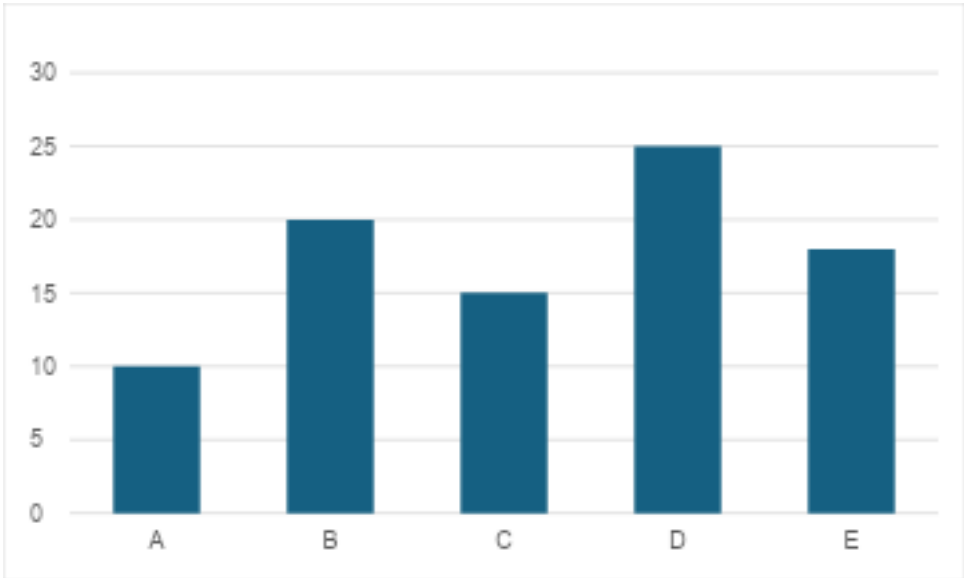

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Direct Quotations

Long quotations (more than 40 words) should be presented as a separate indented block. Leave one blank line before and after the quotation. The quotation should be formatted in Corbel, 11 pt, single line spacing, with a left indentation of 1.5 cm, and without quotation marks. The corresponding APA citation (author, year, and page number) must be provided after the quotation.

Example:

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Statements

Any statements related to the manuscript (e.g., Funding, Conflict of Interest, Data Availability, Ethics Approval, Informed Consent, or similar, where applicable) should be included at the end of the manuscript, immediately before the References section.

Examples:

Funding: This research was funded by the Consellaría de Educación, Ciencia, Universidades e Formación Profesional of the Xunta de Galicia, under grant ED431C2024/XX.

Acknowledgements: Acknowledgements should be placed at the end of the manuscript, immediately before the References section. This section may include recognition of individuals, institutions or organizations that contributed to the research but do not meet the criteria for authorship.

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Data Availability Statement: Authors are encouraged to indicate whether the data supporting the findings of the study are publicly available. If applicable, provide the repository name and DOI or URL. If the data are not publicly available, briefly explain why.

References should be listed in alphabetical order according to APA style guidelines, with the indentation format shown below. Please ensure that all authors cited in the text appear in the reference list, and that all listed references are cited in the text.

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IN-TEXT CITATION EXAMPLES

One author:

Thompson (2021) argues that participatory governance is essential in urban settings.

OR

Participatory governance is essential in urban settings (Thompson, 2021).

Two authors:

Martins and Okafor (2022) explore social imaginaries in youth movements.

OR

Social imaginaries are central to youth movements (Martins & Okafor, 2022).

Three or more authors:

Chang et al. (2020) provide a comparative approach to climate narratives.

OR

A comparative approach to climate narratives has been discussed (Chang et al., 2020).

Direct quotation:

According to Fitzgerald (2018), “modern identities are shaped by recognition politics” (p. 45).

OR

“Modern identities are shaped by recognition politics” (Fitzgerald, 2018, p. 45).
