Press statement by VHP Central General Secretary Shri Milind Parande

Pune, February 21, 2020. The first and most important meeting of the Shri Ram Janmabhoomi Teerth Kshetra Trust was held on February 19, 2020. The revered Shri Nritya Gopal Das Ji Maharaj was appointed as the first trustee and president of the trust, and the revered Shri Champatrai Ji as the general secretary, and the revered Shri Govind Dev Giri Ji Maharaj as the treasurer. The Vishva Hindu Parishad (VHP) expresses its happiness over this. The construction of the Shri Ram Janmabhoomi temple should be carried out using the same design that was used during the movement. The stone carving for the temple construction in Ayodhya has been ongoing for decades. The Hindu community expects the temple to be constructed using the same stones. It is confident that the newly formed trust will certainly accomplish this. Financial and other important decisions were taken by the trust in its first meeting itself. Congratulations to the trust for this prompt action. Now, it can be assumed that the construction of the Shri Ram Janmabhoomi temple will begin soon. He said that the 15 crore rupees hype of a leader like Waris Pathan, a spokesperson of his own party, in the presence of MP Asaduddin Owaisi, will certainly have no effect on Hindus. However, if Muslims accept such irresponsible and wrong leadership, their entire community will not only be put in the dock but will also create a new threat for them. Hindu society is capable of facing all its challenges. We urge the state government to take strict action against such toxic leaders who spread social hatred. The unnecessary issue raised by Mr. Sharad Pawar in Lucknow regarding the formation of a trust for the Ayodhya mosque is nothing but his selfish politics of Muslim appeasement and a new conspiracy to deliberately spread bitterness in society. The Vishwa Hindu Parishad will organize Shri Ramotsav at more than 2 lakh locations across the country with grand Rath Yatras from Varsha Pratipada (March 25, 2020) to Shri Hanuman Jayanti (April 7, 2020). Violent protests are taking place in many places across the country against the Citizenship Amendment Act. Some Muslim-appeasement political parties, radical Jihadi Muslim organizations like the Communist Party and the PFI, and a large section of the Muslim community are clearly behind these protests. The anti-national, anti-Hindu statements and speeches being made during the so-called non-violent protests in Delhi, Chennai, Mumbai, etc., suggest that anti-national forces are also behind them. The VHP condemns all such violent and anti-national protests and demands legal action against those who take the law into their own hands and break it. The VHP is a worldwide Hindu organization. The VHP will fully cooperate in securing citizenship and security in India for all minority Hindus, Jains, Buddhists,

and Sikhs who have taken refuge in India due to religious persecution. Respected saints have also condemned the central government's CAA. We congratulate them on their decision and have made a plan to disseminate accurate information about them. The VHP will also fully support the respected saints in this campaign. Over 3 million Hindus from across the country participated in the ambitious Well-Watchers Campaign organized by the VHP. Over 300,000 Hindus from across Maharashtra alone have joined the VHP. Today, we are conducting over 100,000 service activities in areas such as education, health, financial self-reliance, skill development, and women's empowerment. We also plan to expand this service work in Maharashtra. To expand the work and formulate future action plans, a central meeting of the various VHP departments (dimensions) is held annually.
