

# Opus 48 Prize Draw & Competition Terms & Conditions

1. Our prize draws and competitions are organised by Opus 48, registered with the Charity Commission for England and Wales under number 1179938.

#### How to enter

- 2. Entries received after the stated closing date will not be accepted.
- 3. Our prize draws and competitions are free to enter, and no purchase is necessary.
- 4. Opus 48 will not accept responsibility for entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any postal failure, equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind.
- 5. By submitting an entry, you are agreeing to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. If you have any questions, please contact admin@opus48choir.co.uk.
- 6. Opus 48 reserves the right to refuse entry or refuse to award the prize to anyone in breach of these terms and conditions.

## Eligibility

7. Unless otherwise stated, our prize draws and competitions are open to all except members of Opus 48, agents or any third party directly associated with administration of the prize draw.



- 8. Entrants under 18 must get consent from their parent(s) or legal guardian(s) before entering. The parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of entrants under 18 agree to these Terms and Conditions on behalf of the entrant.
- 9. Only one entry per person is permitted.
- 10. In entering, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim any prize you may win. Opus 48 may require you to provide proof that you are eligible to enter the prize draw or competition.
- 11. Opus 48 reserves all rights to disqualify you if your conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the prize draw or competition.

### The Draw

- 12. A winner will be chosen by random draw performed by a computer process within one month of the prize draw or competition ending.
- 13. The winner will receive details of the prize.
- 14. The winner will be notified by email within 7 days of being chosen and must acknowledge receipt via email. If a winner does not respond to Opus 48 within 14 days of being notified, then the winner's prize will be forfeited and Opus 48 will be entitled to select another winner in accordance with the process described above.
- 15. The prize will be sent to the winner within 14 days of responding to Opus 48.
- 16. The prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered. Opus 48 reserves the right to replace the prize with an alternative prize of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond Opus 48's control makes it necessary to do so.
- 17. The decision of Opus 48 regarding any aspect of the prize draw or competition is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into about it.
- 18. The winner's name can be obtained by sending an email to admin@opus48choir.co.uk within 60 days after the date of the closing date of the prize draw or competition.



19. Opus 48 reserves the right to hold void, cancel, suspend, or amend the promotion where it becomes necessary to do so.

## Limitation of liability

Your statutory rights are not affected.
