

Kindness Week

March 15 - March 18



During the week of March 15, the 4K through 5th grade students will be learning about kindness. There will be class discussions, video lessons, and opportunities to practice being kind to others. Throughout the week, the elementary staff will be on the lookout for students who are being kind, helpful, and caring toward others. The elementary staff will “catch these students being kind” and then write their name on a kindness ticket. The kindness ticket will be added to the student’s class container. Students can earn an extra ‘kindness ticket’ by creating a ‘thank you’ card for our local Gresham Fire and Rescue Department staff. Classroom teachers will determine how this will be implemented for their virtual students. There will be a prize drawing at the end of the day on Monday, March 22, for the students who were “caught being kind” during the week of March 15.

Kindness lessons per school day:

Monday, March 15: (All grades) What is kindness?

Tuesday, March 16: (4K - 1st grade) What is being helpful?
(2nd - 5th grade) What does the expression, “Don’t judge a book by its cover,” mean?

Thursday, March 18: (All grades) What does it mean to use kind words?
