

EKG Technician Certificate— Dual Enrollment Cohort 2025-2026

EKG technicians are responsible for performing electrocardiogram tests in order to monitor and record electrical impulses transmitted by the heart. These tests include basic EKGs, Holter monitoring (portable EKG which records for 24-48 hrs.), 12 lead placement and stress tests (treadmill). They assist a physician in diagnosing and treating cardiac and blood vessel irregularities. EKG technicians work in physician's offices, hospitals, clinics, and other health care facilities and organizations. EKG technicians also work for insurance companies to establish health and life insurance policies. This comprehensive 60-hour EKG Technician Certification Program prepares students to function as EKG technicians and to take the NHA (National Health Career Association) EKG Technician Exam and other national certification exams.
