What to expect:

- The audition will be 1:1. No one else is allowed to view or hear your general audition.
- The audition will begin with vocal warm-ups to check range
- You will sing one of the three following songs:
 - "My Country Tis Of Thee"
 - "You Are My Sunshine"
 - "I've Been Working On The Railroad"

Notes: Please choose the song that best demonstrates your singing style and ability. If you do not know any of these songs, please contact Ms. C

- You will be asked to sight-read some basic rhythms and melodies
- You will be asked to sing a harmony part to your prepared song (listed above)
- You will need to use your ears to sing back individual notes in a chord to identify the highest, lowest, and middle notes after hearing it played on the piano.

What to prepare:

 Nothing! However, you should feel free to practice your chosen song so that you feel comfortable with your choice. You are also encouraged to prepare another song of your choosing, but it is not required.
