3. Staffing Updates
 - a. Principal Stowe shared updates regarding teachers transferring out and/or incoming to Bastain next year.
 - b. The current plan for the number of classes next year (though it is subject to change) is: five (full-day) kindergarten classes; five 1st-grade classes; four 2nd grade classes; five or six 3rd grade classes; six 4th grade classes; five 5th grade classes; five 6th grade classes.
 - c. There are currently 848 students enrolled for Bastain next year.
4. "Meet the Teacher Day" Adjustment
 - a. Each current class will go together to a grade-up classroom to get orientation about their next grade level and get to see all of the teachers in the next grade. Then the class lists will be posted on the last day of school on Skyward.
5. All Day Kindergarten
 - a. There are currently 100 students enrolled for kindergarten at Bastain next year.

- b. A few students (less than 10) have requested half-day kindergarten, so they will have the option to leave school at 11:40 am in order to meet that request. The academic portion of Kindergarten will be implemented in the morning, and Specials rotations will be in the afternoon so that all kindergarten students receive the required curriculum.

6. End of Year Data Celebration

- a. Overall as a school, ~78% of students are at or above reading benchmark, and 61% are reading on grade level. Both of these numbers are up from the past three years.
- b. Since attendance is a major factor in building skills and maintaining education, Principal Stowe is considering implementing attendance rewards next school year.
- c. The council also discussed ideas for student recognition that could be implemented in addition to the current Principal's Pride award program.
