## PARKING & DROP-OFF/PICK-UP INFORMATION

## Please Note - Due to construction there is NO ACCESS to TPHS from Landsdale Dr.

- When dropping off and/or picking up students, please remember to obey all traffic laws and
  posted traffic signs. Avoid dropping off students in designated "No Stopping" areas, and do not
  drive around waiting traffic in an effort to enter a parking area. Please remember that the
  safety of our students is everyone's responsibility.
- All student drop-off and pick-up must take place in the designated areas specified in our <u>TPHS</u>
   <u>Drop-off & Pick-Up Map</u>. Please DO NOT drop-off or pick up students in any of the student or staff parking lots.
- The heaviest traffic on campus is between 8:00 and 8:30 a.m., and then again from 3:20 to 3:45 p.m. To avoid the congestion during the busy times, please make arrangements to arrive early and pick-up later. Students are welcome to spend time in our Learning Commons before and after school.
- When dropping off and/or picking up students, please be considerate of other drivers by keeping the flow of traffic moving, do not block intersections or handicapped access areas.
- To ensure everyone's safety, students should never enter traffic lanes. **All students should cross** at designated crosswalks.
- All drivers should maintain a safe speed while in the TPHS parking lot, especially in the morning and during the release of students at the end of the school day.
- Students and parents should only park in designated areas. Students must have a current
  parking permit to park in the student lot during the school day and should only park in the
  student lot. Student vehicles parked in visitor or staff spaces will be ticketed.
- There is no parking on campus (ex: in front of the gym) or anywhere near the stadium. Please be advised that this rule is enforced for events and activities after school, on weekends, and during holidays. Vehicles parked in these areas may be ticketed and/or towed. Vehicles blocking any construction areas or emergency access lanes will be towed.
