

Lime Grove Traffic Survey summary - Key messages

There are high levels of concern about traffic congestion and road safety with 87% of parents reporting having seen cars mounting kerbs; 56% the lack of safe crossing points; 50% double parking, and 23% inadequate signage.

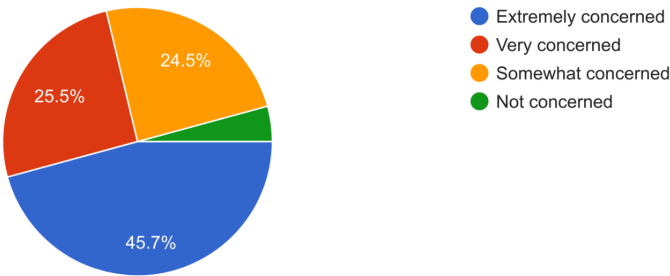
84% of parents strongly support or support the introduction of a School Streets scheme to restrict vehicle access during peak times.

Other suggestions for improvements included a one-way system (35% of parents mentioned this); bollards to prevent kerb mounting, and stricter enforcement of parking regulations.

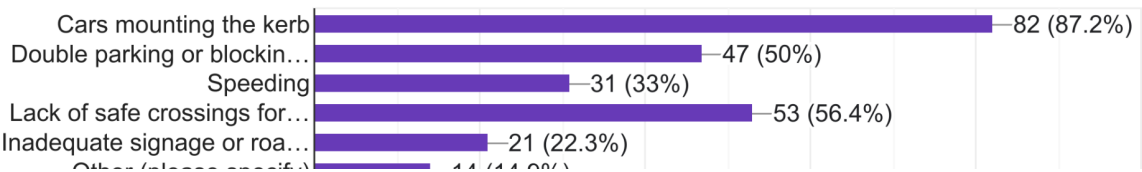
A significant number of parents and their children walk, scoot or cycle daily, with limited reliance on cars or public transport.

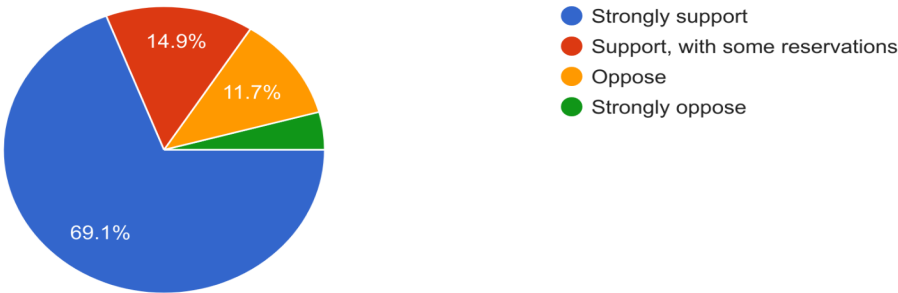


What are the most common road safety issues you've noticed outside the Infant Site? (Please all that apply)
