## Traditional Nursing Program Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree

An **Associate of Arts** or **Associate of Science** degree from Garden City Community College will satisfy the Skills and General Education components of the Newman Studies Program, with the exception of one philosophy course and one theology course. - All Newman University baccalaureate degrees require completion of the Newman Studies Program (NSP), completion of chosen major requirements, a minimum of 124 credit hours, and 30 resident credit hours.
