

Garden City Community College Transfer Track to Newman University

Traditional Nursing Program Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree

An **Associate of Arts** or **Associate of Science** degree from Garden City Community College will satisfy the Skills and General Education components of the Newman Studies Program, with the exception of one philosophy course and one theology course.
