Minutes

- ★ we had discussions on federated search at WOLFcon 2020
- ★ pre-order searching was one of our use cases
- ★ one option would be Elastic search
- ★ there are no concrete plans regarding Elastic search at this point
- ★ There is a rough proposal that has been put together by one of the developers
- ★ Has not been discussed by the Technical Council yet
- ★ There are no specifics so far (e.g. timeline)
- ★ idea is: prepare use cases and requirements to provide to TC members

Requirements:

- ★ One search across all apps
- ★ Display enough details to be able to select the appropriate resource
- ★ need to define required details
- ★ should not be too many, as long as the search results make clear where to look next
- ★ do we need to have dependencies between records displayed in the result list: the POL and related AGL should display as one related result as they represent one title (details for both should display and both records should be selectable from the screen) - or should one of the records display as a default? - which one would that be?

Next steps

- ★ Discuss use cases with RM SIG (May 22nd)
- ★ more different use cases are needed than the ones in the document
- ★ Ask community members to rank the existing feature
- ★ Ask MM SIG and others for use cases - there may be requirements beyond pre-order searching - topic will be discussed in MM meeting on May 28th

- ★ Do we have MM (or RA) use cases?
- ★ When do libraries need the functionality?
