9 athletes go to the finals in field events.

Inside the track oval:

long jump: girls/boys - 2 pits, girls' fence side/boys' track side

triple jump follows long jump: 2 pits: girls' fence side/boys' track side

high jump: boys opening at 5'4", then girls opening at 4'5"

pole vault: girls opening at 6'0", then boys opening at 8'0"

Outside the track oval

Boys' disc followed by girl's disc (infield)

Girls' hammer followed by boys' hammer

Boys shot followed by girls shot

Girls' javelin followed by boys' (synthetic runway)

11:00 AM Track Events Begin:

Track events are boys, then girls. 8 go to finals in 100/110 hurdles and in dash.

Meet Rules and Information:

- Entries are due on Milesplit by 6:00 PM on Thursday, May 21st.

- No entry standard exists for this meet. Each team is allowed four entries per event, one relay per event, and two individual at-large entries. Large entries are either one individual event for two different athletes, or two individual events for one athlete
- Scoring is 1st through 8th places: 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1
- 9 to finals in field events.
- 8 to finals in 100/110 hurdles and in the 100-meter dash.
- TJ - 24' & 28' boards are available for girls; 32' & 36' boards will be available for boys.
- RIIL is providing awards to the top six performances.
- Implements will be certified prior to the meet, and pole vaulters will be weighed in prior to the event.
- Field event warm-ups may only begin when the event official is present. All practicing will cease, and implements will be returned to your team area once the competition has finished.
- When leaving for a track event, athletes must excuse themselves to the field event official and return within 10 minutes.
- This is a RIIL meet; the finish line camera, Hy-Tek, and officials will be provided, but coaches will also need to work events. We need help with clerking, PV, HJ, LJ/TJ, hammer, discus, shot, javelin, and awards. Please send me your preference, and every attempt will be made to honor it.
- There will be a \$7 cash admission fee for spectators at the gate, and concessions will be available for sale during the meet.
- Buses may drop off in front of the track and then park on Clubhouse RD to the rear of the school.
- Team tents should be set up outside of the track fence.
