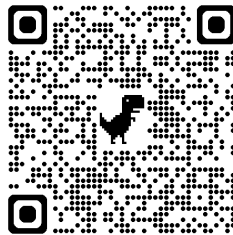




HSB COMMUNITY SCHOOL CATALOG - SUMMER 2025

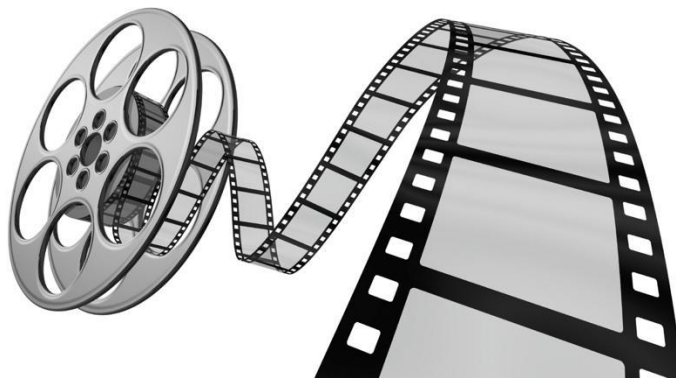
