

Tech Connections in Classrooms

PLEASE NOTE: THERE IS NO TECH SUPPORT AVAILABLE FOR CLASSROOMS. IF YOU CAN NOT CONNECT ON YOUR OWN WITH THE DIRECTIONS BELOW, YOU WILL NEED TO USE ONLY THE EASLE AND MARKERS FOR YOUR BREAKOUTS.

If you have an Apple device :

1. All of the presentation spaces have an AppleTV connected to the projector or TV screen.
2. You can connect to the AppleTV by checking for your room number listed under Screen Mirroring. Depending on your MacOS version, you should be able to find this by going to Control Center - Displays.
3. Click on your Room Number in the list, and your device should connect to the AppleTV. It may prompt you to enter a 4-digit code that will display on the screen in the room.

If you have a PC (or a Mac and would prefer to hardwire to an HDMI port):

1. Find white projector remote (or TV remote, depending on room accommodations).
2. Point at projector on ceiling (or rolling TV) and press power button to turn on
3. Look for an HDMI cable cord connected to a projector (or wall under projector) and connect to your display input: HDMI (windows devices) or mini display/USB-C (MACs).
4. We will have additional adaptors available if needed to connect "HDMI to Mini DisplayPort" and "HDMI to USB-C".
