## Background

## PHM Comment

- . Under this agenda there is a progress report on past plans of action and a call for extension of the tenure of the Framework for Action in building Health Systems resilient to climate change in the WHO South-East Asia Region 2017– 2022, by another five years until 2027 . This agenda item also adopts/ endorses a Regional Plan of Action for the WHO Global Strategy on Health, Environment and Climate Change 2020–2030: Healthy Environments for Healthier

Population. This is a 23 page action plan which has a situation analysis and action points related to tackling the environmental determinants of health, with specific attention to ambient and household air pollution, WASH, chemicals, radiation and climate change. This will take place in several settings, including workplaces, schools, cities, housing and health-care facilities.

This note is useful reading for those working on climate change and the environmental determinants of health in this region. No policy analysis or critical comment is offered as of now.
