Dear Clarksburg Elementary School Caregivers,

An important goal at Clarksburg Elementary School is to ensure that all students achieve academic success. Montgomery County Public Schools uses a Multi Tiered System of Support framework with the goal of supporting students in acquiring the skills to reach their fullest potential in mathematics.

After collecting multiple data points on the achievement of all students, those who are identified as needing additional instruction outside of their math class are recommended for Tier 2 support. Students receiving Tier 2 instruction work toward a specific goal(s) while additional data is collected to monitor their progress. Many students receiving Tier 2 master their goal(s) and return to receiving solely Tier 1 core instruction. With a "flexible" small group approach, students may receive support from their classroom teacher or from additional support staff. Depending on the needs of the student, they may participate in this group for only a few weeks or for an extended period of time. This additional support will allow a child's individual needs to be met through the use and practice of skills and strategies which will target specific areas of need for them. Student progress will be monitored throughout the time in the group in order to ensure growth and identify any further needs that they may have.

Thank you for your continued support at home with your child's math learning.
