Chief Master Sergeant Jamaal E. Chesney serves as the Senior Enlisted Advisor to the Director of Legislative Liaison, Office of the Secretary of the Air Force, Pentagon, Washington D.C. Chief Chesney advises the Director on all congressional interest programs, personnel management, and quality of life. He collaborates directly with the U.S. House of Representatives and U.S. Senate on legislative proposals and provides a direct communication link between Congress and Air Force Senior Staff. Chief Chesney also serves as the primary advisor to the CMSAF and CMSSF regarding congressional engagements, policy changes, hearings, testimony, and legislative concerns impacting the enlisted corps.

Chief Chesney grew up in El Paso, TX and enlisted in the Air Force in December of 2001. His diverse career includes duties as an Intelligence Analyst at bases in Virginia, Hawaii, Texas, South Korea, and Florida with four contingency and combat deployments supporting Operation(s) Southern Watch, New Dawn, Iraqi and Enduring Freedom, and Inherent Resolve.
