INSTRUCTIONAL PLAN

List the steps of the lesson, including instructions for the students.
How will you make sure this lesson is culturally responsive?

- Students come to the carpet to watch you log into google classroom
- Introduce the google classroom as a special place for your class. Discuss the way we behave in the “real” classroom is going to be the same as in the digital google classroom **2-3.DL.7**
- Have all student log into google classroom
- introduce the “stream” on the main page. Show students that this is public and anything you post here can be seen by everyone in our class. Have all students post one thing they love about their class. Have students read other's comments out loud to emphasize that all comments are seen by all.
- Discuss what are some things you wouldn't want to post on the main stream?
 - conversations with just one person
 - conflicts you might be having with someone
 - unkind words
 - If you wouldn't say it out loud in class, you shouldn't type it on the stream.
- Have students access the phonics assignment. Give students directions to complete the syllable sort.
- While students are working on the syllable sort, send a few kids a private encouraging message. Stop students and have them raise their hand if they received a message. Talk about how this is different then posting on the stream.
 - discuss why some messages are private
 - might want to correct a student and not embarrass them
- Have students close their chromebooks and come to the carpet

- Ask the students if any of them logged out (they probably didn't)
- Discuss how since they didn't log out, anyone could open the computer and get onto their account.
- Show students how to log off their computer.
- Where are some other places we use technology?**2-3.CY.1**
 - at home, public library, friend's house, restaurants, etc.
- When are times that we should keep our digital information private and be sure to always log out?
 - library, restaurants, shared devices at school, using a friend's device
- When might we keep our computers signed in or share our passwords?**2-3.CY. 3**
 - at home, at school with a non-shared device, with family
 - remind students that trusted adults at home and at school should have access to their accounts to help them stay safe on the internet
