 - Assign matrix action, assign to Wolfgang?
 - Update milestones for 5.0.0 → a general action “everybody (core devs, others interested) should go through issues”.
- Next release and hotfix
 - Next scheduled release will be 5.0.0 - tentatively scheduled for Wednesday June 13
 - May need a hotfix 4.1.1 to address stability
 - ... all depend on availability of wolfgang and adam
- Update on PRs
 - DW: <https://github.com/eXist-db/exist/pull/1829> ready for proper tests from JW
- General Discussion
 - How did this release go?
 - Wolfgang had problems releasing maven jars
 - Action: research, find a way for others to do this (or keep dependence on Adam)
 - Great! Best eXist yet!
 - Resource / collection URIs - <https://github.com/eXist-db/exist/issues/1824#issuecomment-382231963>
 - Changes here would likely need to be 5.0.0.
 - DW: Suggests approaching from end user perspective. Write tests that should be working: XQuery, WebDAV. Work backwards. For WebDAV consult HTTP spec on risky/forbidden characters like ?, =, +. These may need to be written in Java.
 - Publishing images to dockerhub
 - DP: AR and Grant Mackenzie’s images are receiving a lot of traffic. Docker is very popular among developers; people want good base images. Publishing an official image could help raise visibility. Someone from eXist-db org would need to establish an official account. We’re linking to adam’s images as if they are official, but they are not secure and signed on dockerhub. Next steps? Speak with AR next time?
 - Java 9
 - DP: Question: Can we make use of Java 9’s “modules”?
 - DW: Concerns with pace of Java JDK releases. Moving too fast to adopt Java 9+ features could jeopardize commercial customers. Need to study use cases.
 - DP: Two features of interest in Java 9/10: (1) Java 9 modules. Doesn’t break backward compatibility. (2) Java 10 memory allocations in containers.
 - DW: Is Java community committed to these features? Need to study, understand the big picture.

- A-180423-2 AR: Release an official, secure dockerbase image. Enter eXist-db into the secure dockerhub registry as an organization. Less painful than doing so for maven/nexus. (proposed by DP for AR in absentia)
