

Youth Ministry Intern Part-time

PURPOSE: The purpose of this Internship is to support and encourage Trinity's youth in their faith and walk with Jesus by building relationships with them, providing a positive and enthusiastic presence at youth meetings and activities, and sharing one's own experience following Christ. As a result of this internship, the intern will gain valuable leadership experience and on the job training in youth ministry.

DUTIES: The Youth Ministry Intern shall..

- 1. Lead or assist with youth worship time on Sunday mornings 10am-12noon.
 - arriving 15 minutes early to set up, put out snacks, etc.
 - welcoming teens & engaging them in conversation
 - participating in all activities
 - leading small group discussions
 - occasionally leading games, service projects or devotions
 - helping clean-up after the meeting
- 2. Work with the youth director to plan and lead <u>monthly special events and outings</u> that typically happen on Sunday nights, such as
 - Youth game nights
 - Service Projects
 - Fundraisers
- 3. Work with the youth director and a team of volunteers to lead these annual events:
 - High School Leadership Training (a day in September).
 - Fall Kick-Off Overnighter (September 2nd-3rd).
 - Youth Winter Retreat (December 27-30)
 - 30 hour Famine (Fri night & Sat, possibly last weekend in February).
- 4. Meet with the children, youth and family director weekly for training, check-in, and planning
- 5. Lead other activities and fulfill other responsibilities as necessary
