

- Halla: I've been through a couple of really bad weeks. Also, I will be on holiday next week, to get my birth certificate fixed.
- Wolthera:I spend this week mostly on my text blog post: https://wolthera.info/2022/10/svg-text-layout-for-krita/, this also included some bugreports to the SVGWG. Given the feedback I think this was well-spend effort, people seemed to really appreciate it and overal are a bit more relaxed regarding it. I suspect some anxiety regarding Krita development also has to do with communication, so maybe writing more blogs like these, despite it not being very productive code-wise might be helpful when we're at the end of a big project. This week I'll spend on upstreaming a patch to Raqm and trying to get the font-caching to not break different font-sizes and after that it can be merged for as far as I am concerned.
 - I will need to figure out when to have a discussion with dmitry, I guess.
- Dmitry: I managed to fix the undo corruption bug in the line tool (thanks to freyalupen[m]'s debugging help) I also fixed a few random crashes.
 this week I'm going to first work on crashes, then help Wolthera_laptop with the text caching and finally I wanted to prepare a presentation about lager framework and my branch
- **Deif Iou**: Just wanted to say for the roundtable that this week I continued the investigation on ps blending options / layer effects with good results. There are a lot of parameters that get convoluted in the blending of it all, but I think it can be tackled
- Ivan: This week I worked on my buglist, I closed a few we cannot reproduce anymore and some we cannot fix. Then on Thursday the mac mini had a meltdown, it simply went off, and upon reboot most drivers were bad. I spent one day fixing the thing and updating and a second day reviewing all my patches and cleaning the stash and making proper branches out of them. I have in notes I worked on bug 460631 and rechecked bug 434803 for all assistants
- Amyspark: Last week was dedicated to reviewing upstreaming PRs and Intel's JXL bug. We also got a crash report regarding JXL and a regression involving AVIF, the former was a file that had a magically zapped color space for profile (caused by a botched Adobe RGB detection, cc Wolthera_laptop). And the latter was what enabled me to fix JXL's bug, which was ballooney alpha values before linearization/after delinearization. This was caused by us applying the transfer curves to the alpha values as well. I also got a couple too many bugs reported to Meson as regards stuff

I found during the FFmpeg testing, and I've got one bug report to send to mingw-w64 and another to FFmpeg itself.
