Once again, Suffolk University is pleased to offer dual enrollment courses to Boston Public School students for the spring, 2023 semester. Most classes will meet on campus.

STEP 1

Beginning on November 29, partner representatives may send recommended student transcripts with one collective cover recommendation letter and a list of the students' names and email addresses to the CAS Dean's Office at slenzie@suffolk.edu. The cover letter should label them as BPS Dual Enrollment Program students. Important: All students must be fully vaccinated, including booster shots.

STEP 2

Once transcripts are evaluated, representatives will receive notification of the admissions decisions. Students must be a Junior or Senior and have a 2.5 GPA to be considered. Once approved, students and their partner representatives will receive an updated list of open courses with course descriptions and a link to the application form. I have attached a list of courses here for your information.

Please be sure to follow the instructions above. Applications must be received no later than December 16, 2022. (Students may only register for one course in each semester.)
