

Once again, Suffolk University is pleased to offer dual enrollment courses to Boston Public School students for the spring, 2023 semester. Most classes will meet on campus.

STEP 1

Beginning on November 29, partner representatives may send recommended student transcripts with one collective cover recommendation letter and **a list of the students' names and email addresses** to the CAS Dean's Office at slenzie@suffolk.edu. **The cover letter should label them as BPS Dual Enrollment Program students. Important: All students must be fully vaccinated, including booster shots.**

STEP 2

Once transcripts are evaluated, representatives will receive notification of the admissions decisions. Students must be a Junior or Senior and have a 2.5 GPA to be considered. Once approved, students and their partner representatives will receive an updated list of open courses with course descriptions and a link to the application form. I have attached a list of courses here for your information. **Please be sure to follow the instructions above. Applications must be received no later than December 16, 2022.** (Students may only register for one course in each semester.)
