ELA

When someone tells you, "You think out of the box," what picture do you create in your mind? Do you think about you standing outside a huge box? It really means that you think creatively. This is an example of figurative language. Find and record at least three other examples of figurative language in a book you are reading. Now write the literal meaning beneath your explanation. Why does this author choose to use figurative language?

Math

Watch: Expressions With and Without Parentheses

Think creatively. Using the digits 1, 2, 3, and 4 only once, make an expression that equals 1. Write it on a piece of paper. Then using the same digits, make an expression that equals 2 and then 3, etc. What is the highest number you can get to using only those four digits? Don't forget to use parentheses if you need to.

Social Studies

Read, "The Two Harriets, Heroines of Abolition." Once you have finished the passage try to answer the question sets related to it. How well did you understand the information in this passage? Both Harriet's were real-life heroes. Do you admire one more than the other? If yes, which one and why?

Social and Emotional

Character Traits- What does it FEEL like to have courage? Draw it, describe it to someone, write about it. Part 2-What does a person who has courage look LOOK like? What do their actions look like? Draw someone who has courage, describe her/him to someone, write about him/her. Why is this character trait important to have?

Science

Rain is a type of precipitation and an important component of the water cycle. Watch the <u>video</u>, "Can we make it rain?" Try one of the <u>Rainmaker Experiments</u>. Record what happened in your experiment. Imagine how the ability to make it rain could change our water supply!
