UPDATED July 17, 2026 Horse Committee Maintenance

(Saturday, July 18 10-2

- Check Ring B for excess dirt and pull excess into the ring
- Clean farrier shed after hay bales are removed
- **Clean ring b announcers stand
- Clean up area around fair sign pulling/weed eating weeds
- Clean up area around wash rack pulling/weed eating weeds
- Dig out Ring A/Ring B gates areas
- Inventory and organize little red barn by ring A and ring B shed and wash everything (bring buckets and rags)
- Pick up rocks everywhere AND put them in front of window facing ring at Low Family Saddle Horse Show Office
- Power wash or wash picnic tables in grassy area (bring power washer or buckets and rags)

- Put up mini pens in barn 10 if here
- **Rake fence along east side of horse area
- Stack blue cans by red barn/weed eat around building
- Wash fence around warm up ring and paddock
- Wash walls in bathrooms (women's big wall is done)
- Wash white vinyl fence at paddock and warm up ring (outside $\frac{3}{4}$, inside $\frac{1}{4}$)
- Wash white wood fence around ring B ($\frac{1}{2}$ is done)
- Wash windows in Low Family Saddle Horse Show Office
- Weed eat around little red barn
- Weed Ring B north

Friday, July 24, 5-7pm WORK DAY

- Hand mow around announcer's booth or weed eat the area including front, back and pavilion
- Hand mow/weed eat around Ring B between ring and barn
- Remove rocks from rings A and B anywhere a horse walks-put in rock area by announcer's stand Ring A
- Weed eat around Low Family Saddle Horse Show Office (bring weed eaters)
- Weed eat around ring A and ring B (bring weed eaters)
- ****Hang banners on fence****
