• 7 Tips for Finding Your First SCUBA Cache

 Get certified. Before attempting, make sure you have proper <u>scuba</u> <u>certification</u>.

- Read cache details carefully as every scuba cache is different. Some will require park entrance fees while others may ask you to notify the local park ranger.
- Research the diving area and its ecosystem. You don't want to be unpleasantly surprised by the local sea creatures or water temperature.
- Bring a compass. GPS devices will not work underwater but a compass will help you navigate while submerged in water. You can also triangulate the position of the geocache based on provided landmarks – certain cache listings will specify. **All good divers should have this as standard qear!
- Buddy system is a must. In the off-chance that something were to happen (an underwater current), you want to make sure someone knows where you are.

**I'm a certified Solo Diver

- Bring a pencil or waterproof writing utensil to sign the logbook.
 Standard pens won't work when wet.
- Carry an underwater camera... so you can snap a shot of yourself finding the cache!
