In 2020, the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) adopted the Indiana Academic Standards for Mathematics. The Indiana Academic Standards are a set of guidelines for what students in Indiana should know and be able to do in various subjects, including English language arts, mathematics, science, social studies, and others. These standards help educators determine what content and skills should be taught in each grade level and provide a basis for evaluating student performance and progress. BHMSD believes all students can learn and should have multiple opportunities to be successful. All students are in the Multi-tiered Systems of Support MTSS process and needs are addressed accordingly:

Tier 1: Universal

All students receive high-quality classroom curriculum through whole group, small group differentiated instruction, teacher-designed interventions by the classroom teacher within the general education setting.

Tier 2: Supplementary

In addition to classroom instruction, students identified as needing intervention receive supplemental instruction aligned to the core curriculum that targets specific area or areas of need. Progress is monitored to determine improvement.

Tier 3: Intensive

In addition to classroom and supplemental instruction, students needing intensive instruction to target specific skill deficits receive intensive instruction. Progress is monitored to determine improvement.
