After School Program Student Transportation Release Form

A late bus route has been established for students attending after-school programs and tutoring. With the exception of Kindergarten through Grade 3 students, all students are generally considered eligible to be "self-released" and permitted to walk home independently from their designated bus stop.

If a student who is Kindergarten through Grade 3 has an older sibling who can walk them from the bus stop, this release form would still need to be completed.

Students will be released by the bus driver at the posted drop-off time listed on the district website (www.cusd49.com), regardless of whether a parent or guardian is present, unless a written request has been submitted to the district asking that the student not be self-released.

The Columbia Union School District reserves the right to require that a parent, guardian, or authorized adult be present at the bus stop for student pick-up, regardless of prior parental permission for self-release. This may be based on individual student needs, age, safety concerns, behavioral considerations, or other extenuating circumstances as determined by school or transportation staff in the best interest of student safety.

Buses may arrive up to five (5) minutes before or after the scheduled time.
